RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR ALL CONTESTANTS

Parents/Guardians & Contestants Must Read the Contents of These Rules and Regulations Pages Thoroughly. Parental/Guardian Consent for Contestants Under 18 Must Be Obtained to Register for The Pageant.

- 1. Pageant is **OPEN** to all Kentucky residents.
- 2. Entry fee is \$50.00. Contestants will compete as a couple.
- 3. Contestants must have reached his/her 5th birthday and cannot have reached his/her 8th birthday by June 30th.
- 4. A copy of the original state issued birth certificate must be included with the application for both contestants. We must have a copy of the original birth certificate with application for it to be considered submitted. We will NOT accept a photo, screenshot, email, or the original being shown to us. We must have a copy on file with the application before the pageant starts or contestants will be disqualified. No monetary fees will be refunded. NO EXCEPTIONS!
- 5. <u>Individual Photo Contest</u> (not as couples) (Optional) \$5/1 or \$10/3 4x6 size photos only. Categories include **Most Photogenic**, **Prettiest Eyes**, and **Prettiest Smile**. Only one 4x6 photo per category can be submitted. Print contestants name and category on the back of each 4x6 photo submitted. Photos will NOT be judged & money will NOT be refunded if you submit professional photos of any type, headshots, altered photos or any size photo other than a 4x6. Photos submitted will NOT be returned. One winner per category for girls & the same for boys will be chosen and will receive a medallion.
- 6. Contestants will be judged as a couple on poise, natural beauty (no make-up allowed), personality, and their presence & natural responses during their on-stage interview.
- 7. This is a "NATURAL PAGEANT". The term "NATURAL PAGEANT" means that contestants will not be permitted to wear hairpieces, extensions, flippers, false eyelashes, spray tans, and no make-up. Only clear lip gloss is allowed, no color of any kind.
- 8. <u>Wardrobe</u>: Contestants will wear blue jean shorts (no holes in them), a white shirt, & sandals or white tennis shoes. They can wear any style or color of belts or hair accessories. <u>Absolutely no</u> other style of outfit is permitted.
- 9. The Judges Panel have been instructed to deduct a minimum of 1 point (and above if they deem it necessary) from scores should they see any of the above that is not permitted on the contestants.
- 10. Winners will receive the following: Girl- crown, sash, sash pin, award, ribbon, and flowers. Boy- crown, sash, sash pin, ribbon, and award. 2nd & 3rd place will receive awards and ribbons.
- 11. Winners will represent the Jessamine County Fair in August, the opening day of the state fair in Louisville at the Little Miss & Mr. Kentucky County Fair State Pageant.

- 13. Ways to Submit Application:
 - A) By mail
 - B) Drop Box
 - C) Signing up the night of the pageant.
- A. <u>Sending by mail</u> must be postmarked by July 1st. Include the completed entry form, copy of contestant's birth certificate (state issued), photos (labeled correctly) if entering photo contest and correct form of payment.

- Must arrive no later than 6pm at the pageant at the <u>registration table</u> to get your contestant number. No entries will be accepted after 6:15pm.
- B. <u>Drop box</u> will be found on the front porch of the mailing address. Applications can be placed into the drop box between 8am-8pm until Tuesday, July 8th. Make sure to include entry form, correct form of payment, copy of birth certificate, & 4x6 photos if entering photo contest in a sealed envelope labeled Little Miss & Mr. There will be a folder with applications if you need one.
 - Must arrive no later than 6pm at the pageant at the <u>registration table</u> to get your contestant number. No entries will be accepted after 6:15pm.
- C. <u>Sign up the night of the pageant</u>. Please bring the required paperwork, correct form of payment & 4x6 photos (labeled correctly) if entering photo contest. Applications will be available @ the sign-up table.
 - We will start taking sign-ups at 5pm and no later than 6pm @ the sign-up table. No entries will be accepted after 6:15pm.
- 14. The contestants' name, age, complete address, telephone number, e-mail address must be correct on the application.
- 15. Visit the Kentucky County Fair State website @ www.kafs.net for more information on the state pageant. State paperwork must be submitted within 2 weeks from pageant date and a copy sent to the director by email. Not submitting the state paperwork within the required time period is grounds for disqualification.
- 16. If the winning contestant is not able to participate in the state pageant, you must give at least 2 weeks' notice to the director by phone and a written statement by email. As to give the runner-up enough notice to compete. Failure to do so will result in forfeiture and the runner-up will assume the duties and responsibilities and receive all the awards.
- 17. Only one designated person per contestant is allowed in the dressing rooms. There will need to be one designated adult with the girl contestant in Dressing Rm A & one designated adult with the boy contestant in Dressing Rm B while getting ready. No running in & out of dressing rooms! Please respect the privacy of the contestants.
- 18. No cameras, video cameras, tablets or cell phones allowed in dressing rooms. This rule will be strongly enforced. If anyone is caught using a camera or cell phone, they will be confiscated and will result in disqualification from the pageant. This rule also applies to the designated person in the dressing room with the contestant.
- 19. Grounds for disqualification can be but not limited to untrue statements on registration forms, unruly behavior, misconduct, obscene or foul language in public or posted on any social media platforms or any other reasons the pageant committee may deem, as necessary.
- 20. Anyone that causes any problems, harasses the directors or judges will be escorted off the premises and re-entry not allowed.
- 21. If the pageant committee is harassed or untrue statements are placed online, on any social media platforms, websites or by any other means, the contestant will be disqualified from our pageant system entirely.
- 22. The Jessamine County Fair is not responsible for any accidents, injury, or loss of individual property.
- 23. The judge's decision will be final. No refunds! No Exceptions!
