**RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR ALL CONTESTANTS**

This pageant is open to any county in Kentucky.

1. Must be 2 yrs. of age & older as of June 30<sup>th</sup>.
2. **Qualifications:** Must provide disability in the form of a Front page of an IEP from school, 504plan, SSI paperwork, Disability Award Letter, or a Dr. 's Note with their letterhead.
3. **Ways to Sign up:** By Mail or Day of the Pageant. Must send application with proof of disability paperwork back mail postmarked by deadline or placed in drop box. More Details provided on page 4.
4. **Sign Up the day of the pageant:** Must arrive between 5pm and no later than 5:30pm. We will have a table set up labeled "**Sign Ups** You must bring your proof of disability paperwork and fill out an application on site unless you have all your required paperwork with you. The parent/guardian that will be with the contestant or escorting the contestant on stage, if assistance is needed, will receive the contestant's number.
5. **Mailed in your paperwork; must be post marked by July 5<sup>th</sup>**
6. **Contestants will receive crowns and sashes and other awards**
7. If there are any problems you feel you need to bring to our attention or questions, please direct them to the pageant committee.
8. Absolutely no cameras, video cameras, tablets or cell phones are allowed in the dressing room areas for privacy reasons! No males allowed in dressing rooms. They are allowed to escort the contestant on stage but must stay out of the dressing room if any girl contestant is getting ready. Only one adult per contestant will be allowed in the dressing room to assist the contestant. No running in & out of dressing rooms due to privacy issues!
9. The girls can wear any type of dress or outfit of their choice. But we ask that if you wear a pageant dress that they do not wear heels. Please wear wedge or flat shoes.
10. The boys can wear any type of outfit that they desire to wear.
11. Every contestant that requires assistance must be escorted on stage by a parent, guardian, or volunteer. The younger age group must always have someone on stage with them. It is your responsibility to make sure you keep your child safe while on stage.

12.If wheelchair ramp access is needed for the stage, there is one available located on the side of the stage near dressing room B.

13.We want to give equal opportunity to each participant so it's up to each contestant and their comfort level which parts of the stage they want to use. Contestants will be announced to come out onto the stage and can use the entire middle of the stage and runway. Younger age groups must always have someone on stage with them holding their hand. If your child is in a wheelchair or motorized wheelchair, they will use the ramp located on the side of the stage near dressing room B, to come out onto the stage. We do not want anyone to fall off stage or runway so please make sure to be careful while on stage. We do not want anyone to harm themselves. We are not responsible for any accidents that occur on or off stage.

14.I agree that any photos or videos submitted or taken during the event may be used for advertising purposes on the website, print, or any social media platforms.

15.The Jessamine County Fair, volunteers or pageant committee, is NOT responsible for any accidents that may occur on the Fairgrounds.
